The International Relations Office provides this document to explain and clarify our credit and assessment system aiming to cooperate with the applications of our students.

Credit System

The Article nº 110 from UFRGS General Regulations, published at the Brazilian Official Journal in January 1996, defines the credit system of our University. The article states that 1 (one) credit corresponds to a workload of 15 hours of classes, during the whole term. Check the table below to find further information:

Assessment System

The Article nº 7 of Resolution nº 09/2003 of the EREC, defines that the “I3” indicate the harmonic mean of the accredited qualifications given to the grades obtained by the student in all of the subjects of its course. The qualification of each grade is: 10 (ten) corresponding to A, 8 (eight) corresponding to B, 6 (six) corresponding to C, 3 (three) corresponding to D, 2 (two) for the canceled or locked subjects and 1 (one) corresponding to FF. The students are ranked in a decreasing order.
