Para solicitar a bolsa ELAP não é possível candidatar-se a outra universidade canadense além de ULaval, UdeM e UQAM. Entre a documentação obrigatória para a candidatura à bolsa, é preciso enviar uma cópia do acordo de cooperação entre a universidade de origem do candidato e a UFRGS.

Observe-se que há uma diferença entre “protocolo” e “convênio de intercâmbio”. Os convênios de intercâmbio oferecem isenção de taxas acadêmicas (matrícula e mensalidades) para os alunos selecionados pela UFRGS dentro de um número determinado de vagas, listadas no edital Campus Internacional. Caso alunos da UFRGS queiram estudar nas universidades com as quais temos somente protocolo, não haverá qualquer isenção de taxas e o aluno será recebido na universidade canadense como *free mover*.

- **Signed copy of Memorandum of Understanding or Agreement with the partner institution:** a written agreement or understanding, in English or in French, signed by both institutions indicating that tuition fees will not be charged and containing any other clauses of mutual interest. The specific clause in which the tuition fees are waived must be indicated. Note: a signed copy of this document is mandatory for undergraduate and college applications. For graduate applications, if the exchange is made under a signed agreement, it is strongly suggested that it be included with the application.

A primeira etapa para os alunos da UFRGS é candidatar-se a uma das três universidades canadenses através do edital Campus Internacional, preenchendo os requisitos do edital , prazos e os requisitos específicos de proficiência informados no Anexo I.

Supporting documents

The following documents must be uploaded and attached to the online application form in one of the following formats: .pdf, .jpg, .doc, .docx, .txt or .gif. Each document must be smaller than 5 MB in order for the application to upload successfully.

- **Proof of citizenship:** a copy of the candidate's passport or national identity document with valid dates. Note: a driver's licence, permanent resident card, student card or baptism certificate is not accepted as proof of citizenship. The country of citizenship selected in the online application form must be the same as the country of the proof of citizenship.
- **Proof of full-time enrolment:** a letter in English or French from the home institution, on official letterhead, dated within the last six months, confirming that the candidate is currently enrolled in a full-time program and will continue to be enrolled upon their return and providing the expected completion date of the degree. Note: copies of transcripts, a student card or letter of admission are not acceptable (maximum one page).
- **Letter of intent from the candidate:** a letter in English or French from the candidate describing the nature of their research or studies to be undertaken and explaining the rationale for study in Canada and for the choice of institution, the program and the supervisor. The candidate must also indicate how the proposed program of study or research will relate to their future career (maximum one page).
- **Letter of support from the home institution:** a letter in English or French from the candidate's instructor, professor or international director on the institution's official letterhead explaining the nature of study and how the candidate and the home institution will benefit from this scholarship program (maximum one page).
- **Letter of invitation from the Canadian supervisor:** applications for graduate students must include a letter from the Canadian supervisor indicating their willingness to support and mentor the candidate. This letter must be on institutional letterhead, be in English or in French, be signed and demonstrate the support for the candidate during the exchange period and demonstrate how the Canadian institution, supervisor and peers will benefit (maximum one page).
- **Signed copy of Memorandum of Understanding or Agreement with the partner institution:** a written agreement or understanding, in English or in French, signed by both institutions indicating that tuition fees will not be charged and containing any other clauses of mutual interest. The specific clause in which the tuition fees are waived must be indicated. Note: a signed copy of this document is mandatory for undergraduate and college applications. For graduate applications, if the exchange is made under a signed agreement, it is strongly suggested that it be included with the application.
- **Privacy Notice Statement:** a copy of the [Privacy Notice Statement for non-Canadian participants](#) dated and signed by the candidate.
